NARRATIVE DESCRIPTION

The Evangelical Covenant Mission Church was listed in the Register of Historic Kansas Places on July 13, 1979. Built in the late 19th century, this building was significant for its association with the early Swedish community of Osage City and as an excellent example of Gothic architecture.

The building was demolished sometime between 2012 & 2014. The building's lot is now vacant. The loss of the resource negatively affects its historic integrity, and the Kansas State Historic Preservation Office requests the property be removed from the Register of Historic Kansas Places.
