

Kansas Historic Sites Board of Review

February 13, 1982

The Kansas Historic Sites Board of Review convened at 1:15 p.m. in the conference room of the Memorial Building. Members present were Prof. Curtis Besinger, Prof. James L. Forsythe, J. Eric Engstrom, Del D. Knauer, Robert W. Richmond (designee for Governor Carlin), Sister Monica Schneider, Joseph W. Snell, Ellen May Stanley, Prof. Ray B. Weisenburger, and Thomas A. Witty. Staff members present were Dick Pankratz, Martin Stein, Terry Marmet, Nora Pat Small, and Joy Harnett.

Robert Richmond moved that the immediate past chairman, J. Eric Engstrom, be re-elected chairman. Joe Snell moved that Ellen May Stanley be re-elected as vice chairman. Both motions were seconded by James Forsythe and passed unanimously.

Ellen May Stanley moved the acceptance of the minutes of the previous meeting. The motion was seconded by Curtis Besinger and approved.

A brief discussion was held on the rules of procedures adopted by the previous board. A motion was made by James Forsythe and seconded by Sister Monica Schneider that these be adopted as temporary rules. The motion carried.

Joseph Snell suggested that the staff could review the rules prior to the next meeting and make recommendations for changes necessitated by changes in pertinent laws and that each board member could also review the rules and be prepared to recommend changes. Curtis Besinger moved the acceptance of that suggestion. It was seconded by Ellen May Stanley and approved.

Saturday, April 3, was designated as the next meeting for the review board. At the present time there is a consensus for Saturday meetings.

Dick Pankratz informed the board that since J. C. Steele house at Clinton lake in Douglas county had been razed by the Corps of Engineers, it was necessary for the board to take action to remove it from the state register and recommend its removal from the National Register. Curtis Besinger moved those actions. The motion carried.

The next item of business was the consideration of national and state register nominations. Nora Pat Small showed slides of the proposed properties and summarized their significance. The board approved the following properties for both the National Register and state register. There were no dissenting votes and no recorded abstentions on any of the properties. The board members making and seconding motions for approval are identified.

Kansas Historic Sites Board of Review  
April 3, 1982

Chairman J. Eric Engstrom convened the Kansas Historic Sites Board of Review at 10:00 a.m. in the conference room of the Memorial Building. Other members present were Prof. Curtis Besinger, Prof. Carlyle S. Smith, Del D. Knauer, Bill Muir (designee for Governor Carlin), Sister Monica Schneider, Joseph W. Snell, Ellen May Stanley, and Thomas Witty. Staff members present were Dick Pankratz, Nora Pat Small, Martin Stein and Maudenna A. Woods.

Ellen May Stanley moved the acceptance of the minutes of the previous meeting. The motion was seconded by Del Knauer and approved.

The next item of business was the update on program activities. Dick Pankratz announced that the publication entitled "Kansas Rock Art" was received from the printer March 25, 1982. Mr. Pankratz said that Martin Stein deserves the credit for the value and usefulness of the publication. Copies were distributed to board members.

Mr. Pankratz informed the board that Julie Wortman had resigned and that the job had been offered to Nora Pat Small who had accepted. Her temporary appointment has ended and after a short trip east she will be on the job May 3.

Mr. Pankratz stated that all properties approved for National Register listing on February 13 have been sent in to the National Register office in Washington, D.C. Properties which have been listed on the National Register since the last meeting are:

Kansas listings on the National Register now total 300.

Mention was made that requests for the courthouse book continue to come in and that the book is being reprinted by the private Kansas State Historical Society.

Mr. Pankratz suggested that the board set a calendar of future meeting dates. The following were agreed on: early February, early May, mid August, and mid November. The board will be notified by mail to determine specific dates and times.

Eric Engstrom talked briefly about the National Conference of State Historic Preservation Officer annual meeting which was held in Charleston, which he, Joe Snell and Dick Pankratz attended.

Attorneys for Archbishop Strecker have threatened Joe Snell with the possibility of a lawsuit if he submits the nomination of the St. Mary's Church in Kansas City to the Department of the Interior for a determination of eligibility. The regulations require that this be submitted since it has been approved by the board for Register nomination, and it has been done. The matter has been turned over to the Attorney's General office.

The Historic Preservation Department is co-sponsor of two tax incentives workshops in Topeka (May 6) and Wichita (May 10). The other sponsor is the National Conference of State Historic Preservation Officers. Terry will be the only staff member to have responsibilities in the workshops.

Problems with the federal audit have been settled. All questions have been resolved and no funds are to be returned. A letter so stating has been received.

Changes to the rules of procedure were discussed. It was decided to make the changes suggested by the staff which would make the rules consistent with the 1981 state law.

The last item of business was the consideration of national and state register nominations. Nora Pat Small and Martin Stein showed slides of the proposed properties and summarized them briefly. The board members making and seconding motions for approval as well as those abstaining are identified. All were approved.

The November issue of "Preservation Update" was distributed at the meeting. However, they are listed on the state register. Interim regulations give federal agencies control over nominations of their properties. However at such time as these two properties might be transferred, sold, or otherwise disposed of, the Sec. 106 process will be invoked and a formal determination of eligibility obtained.

Ms. Small reported briefly on a seminar she attended in Austin on state comprehensive preservation planning. Mr. Stein presented an overview of his archeological survey work in Scott county this past September.

The board then considered properties for national and state register listing. Larry Jochims presented a thematic nomination of 11 Marsh arch bridges. All were approved for the National Register except for one in federal ownership (Cedar Creek Bridge near Valley Falls in Jefferson county). All were approved for the state register. 
