

In Congress July 11th 1776

Resolved, That an Application be made to the Committee of Safety of New York for a Supply of Flint for the Troops at New York

That the President write to the Govenors of Maryland and Delaware, & Request them to order by their Militia for the Dutying Camp with all Expedition, and to March there without Delay to the City of Philadelphia

That Copies of the Declaration be sent to the several Assemblies, Conventions & Councils of Liberty, & to the several Commanding Officers of the Continental Troops, that it be published in each of the aforesaid States, and at the Head of the Army


That the said Committee be instructed to order the Militia of the aforesaid States, as far as they belong to the Continent, to be sent to the General at New York, under the Command of John Adams & M^r Jefferson being in a Quire for a that for the Militia of the State of New York

Resolved, That a Letter be written by the President, to Gov^r of New York, Requesting him to order M^r Jeffrey Carpenter to be sent to the Militia of General Schuyler at Albany as soon as possible, to order the Militia of the State, to be engaged on the best Terms, at the Expence of the Continent

Resolved, That an order be given to the Commandant of the Battalion of Delaware Troops, to station one Company at the Head of the Army, and to March the remaining part of his Battalion to Wilmington from whence they are to march to Philadelphia & there remain until the further order of the Congress
